TEMA.

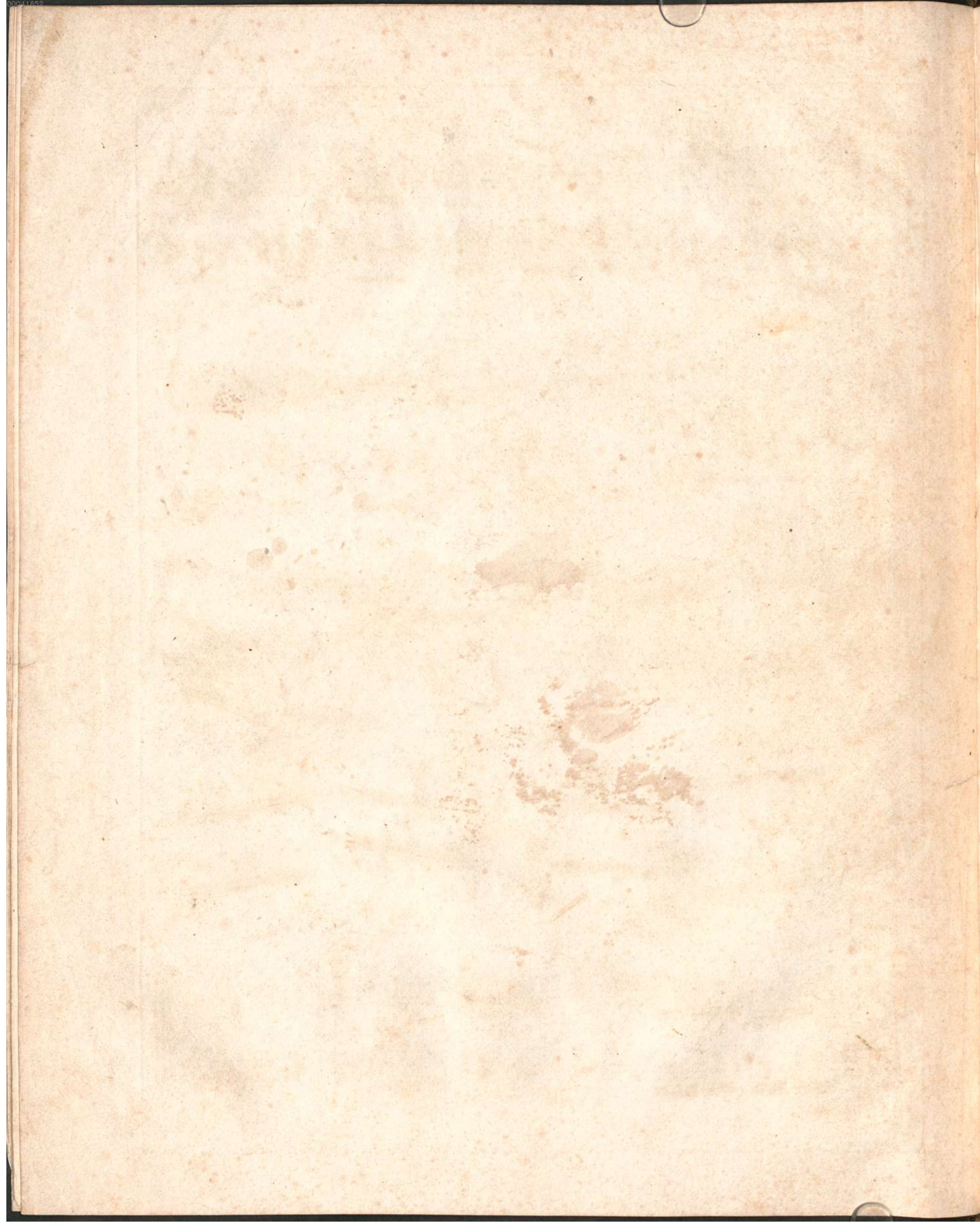

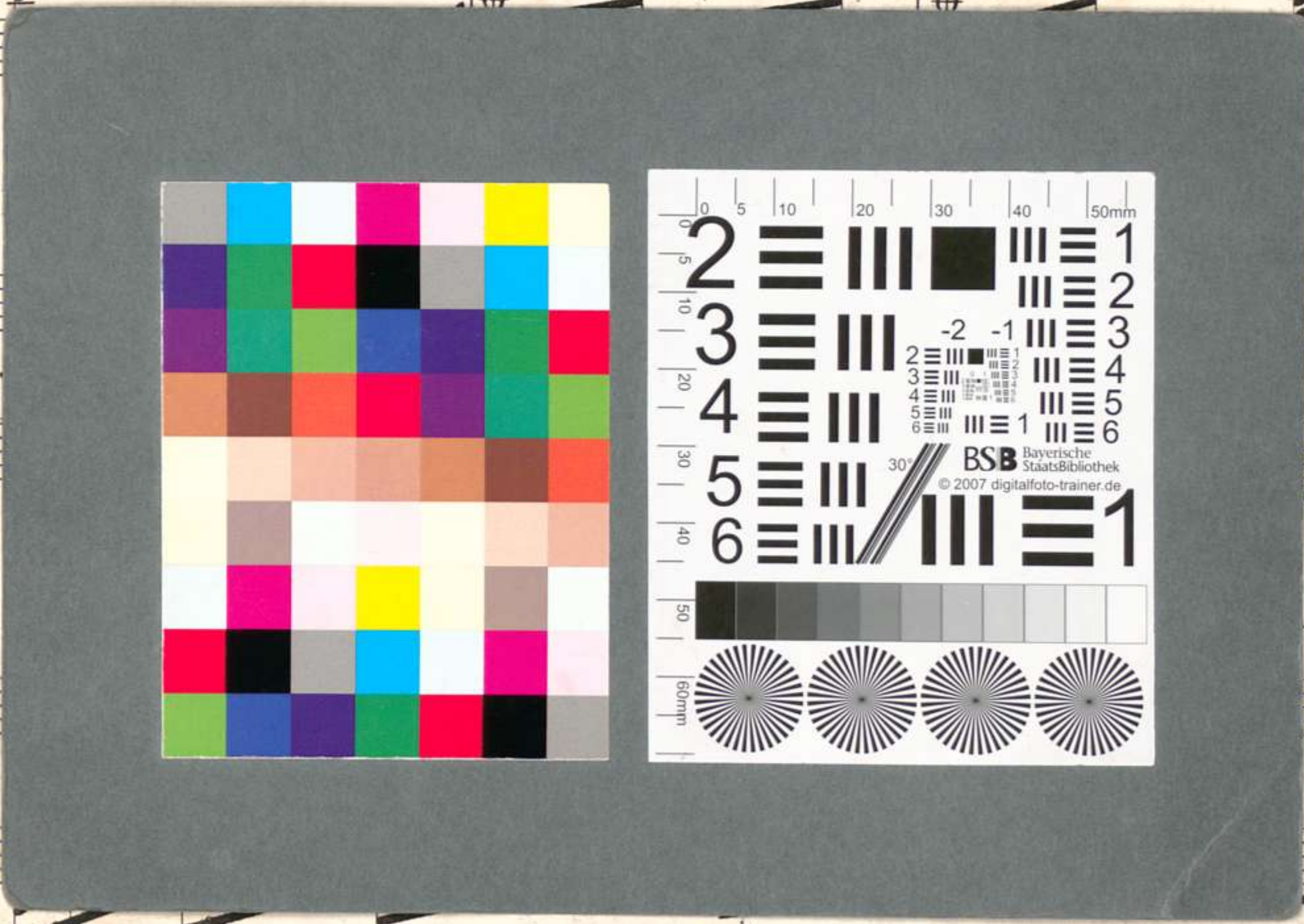
