Agitato.

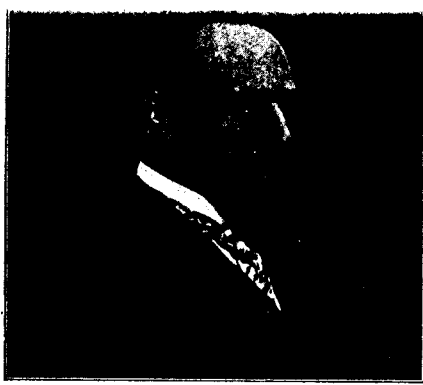
