


Sonata. Published source: Edition of Breitkopf & Härtel. Thanks to the generosity of the Marchese de Casanova, the editor was able to compare a manuscript of Liszt's that bears the notation: "Terminé le 2 Février 1853." It was extremely interesting to observe the phases that various passages passed through before they attained their final form. In addition, numerous engraver's errors and inaccuracies could be corrected from the manuscript.

The introduction was originally planned with a further doubling:
